

Saviynt Integration Guide

Saviynt is a converged Identity and Access Management (IAM) platform that unifies Identity Governance and Administration (IGA), Access Management, Privileged Access Management (PAM), and Third-Party Access Management into a single cloud-native solution. A GreyMatter integration with Saviynt enables organizations to enhance security operations through enrichment and remediation actions within their identity infrastructure.

Deployment Type

This integration supports **private cloud** deployments through **port 443**.

If you already know that your environment supports these deployments, continue to the next step. If you are unsure, please check your organization's compatibility before continuing.

Required Information and Setup

To integrate GreyMatter with Saviynt, collect the following details:

- URL
- Username (with API Access)
- Password
- API Path
 - Default: api/v5
